I would like to begin by thanking you for your interest in our Hebrew School. I know that you as a parent have many choices when it comes to educating your children and I appreciate the opportunity to express why I think that we offer the best supplemental Judaic education around.

It's for this reason that first and foremost our staff provides for a positive Jewish experience. This year Hebrew School will be held at our facility in Wellington located at 13860 Wellington Trace at the corner of Green View Shores Blvd. (2 doors from the IHOP). The time remains the same on Sundays from 9:30-12:00.
